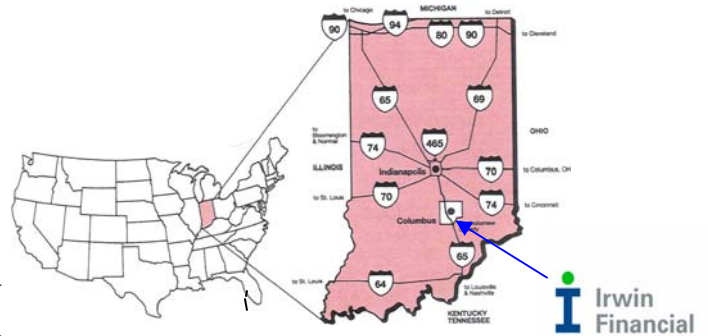




Position: Corporate Analyst Intern
